Over the past several years, our interns have researched and drafted memoranda on various legal issues for cases in active litigation, including cases pending before the Fifth and Eleventh Circuit Courts of Appeals; evaluated data pursuant to the investigation of alleged systemic discrimination; and participated in settlement conferences. Interns may also attend the moot court arguments that our trial attorneys do in preparing for trials in district courts.
